Admission Procedure/Requirements

I. Jain Academy for Sporting Excellence commences its first batch from July 04. The sports disciplines offered at the Academy are:

II Academic curriculum of the trainees will be through Jain International Residential School (JIRS) which is affiliated to CBSE / NIOS.

III Selection of trainees will be conducted on the basis of :-

- Sports - achievements and a battery of test.
- Academics - Written test on Basic English & Mathematics.

IV The following documents will have to be submitted while admitting the child to the academy :-

- Transfer Certificate/School leaving Certificate (in original) from the school in which the student last studied.
- Marks Sheet of the last examination in the previous school
- 24 passport size photographs (colour) with its negative.
- Details of the Local Guardian in a separate sheet of paper, indicating the name, relationship, address, telephone Number, FAX No & E-mail ID.
- Declaration of Second/Third Language selected out of Hindi/French/Sanskrit)**
- Students for XI Standard should produce X Standard marks sheet issued by the respective Board alongwith Migration Certificate and Character/Conduct Certificate in addition to Transfer/School Leaving Certificate.
- Passport of the child. In case the Passport is not readily available, the same is to be applied for and submitted to the academy within two months from the date of admission.
- Sports achievement certificates - State / National / Other if any.
- Recomendations from sports bodies.

**Students seeking admission to classes upto VIII Standard have to opt for 2nd and 3rd languages out of Hindi/French and Sanskrit. Students seeking admission to classes IX and X Standard should opt only second language out of the above three languages.

V The child while joining the academy should bring the items shown in the list at Annexure 1 & 2.

VI Date of opening of academy will be intimated well in advance.

Undertaking- 1

(To be signed and returned with the application form by parents)

I understand that my son / daughter is granted admission to Jain Academy for Sporting Excellence on the following terms and conditions:

1. That I will deposit the Transfer Certificate of the previous school within 15 days of his/her joining the Academy, failing which the Executive Director will have the right to cancel the admission and send the student home.
2. That I will deposit the fees in full on or before the due date. If not, after 30 days, the name of the trainee will be struck off the register.
3. That I have studied the leave rules of the institution. I understand that the academy celebrates all religious festivals and no home leave is permissible for religious functions. In addition to travelling time, only two days leave for attending the marriages of real sisters or brothers or parents' brothers or sisters and to offer condolence to immediate relations is permissible. An invitation card should accompany the request for leave for attending the marriage. No leave is granted for Birthday and Raksh Bandhan, etc., and no leave is permissible for any of the above reasons during the examination days. I also understand that no leave will be granted to the student unless I apply for it directly to the Executive Director.
4. That the trainee will continue to train at the academy for a minimum period of one year.
5. That no food parcel will be sent to the student.
6. That the student will not be given any cash. All the money required for the student will be sent to the Academy office.
7. That if my ward leaves the Academy campus without permission, the Academy authorities may lodge an F.I.R. with the local police station and I shall have no right to question and raise objections to this action. The academy will not be responsible for any mishap in such circumstances.
8. That the student may be removed from the academy for
 - a non-payment of Academy dues
 - b using unfair means in any examination
 - c consistent unsatisfactory progress
 - d conduct harmful to other students
 - e immorality
 - f grave insubordination
 - g stealing or extortion of money / items from other students
 - h contempt of authority
 - i breaking bounds
 - j damaging of the institution property
 - k any word or action likely to undermine the reputation of the institution
 - l bullying, assaulting and ragging in any form
9. That the academy does not hold any responsibility in cases of sickness or accidents. This applies also to all accidents which may occur in the science laboratories, workshops, sports fields, gymnastics, boxing, rock climbing, trekking, mountaineering, Microlite Flying, Parasailing, swimming, equestrian activities, educational tours or journeys to and from the academy.

Please note: Visitors will not be allowed to visit the dormitories.

10. That leave will not be granted on the pretext of illness of relatives, including the parents, except under very special circumstances.
11. That the Academy will do its best to provide normal medical aid, but the Academy will not be held responsible for any accident or mishap beyond its control.
12. That no valuables like gold chains, rings, transistors, personal stereo systems, cameras, etc., are to be given to the students. The Academy does not take responsibility for the loss of such valuables
13. That the parents who wish to withdraw their children at the end of a term will have to give a notice of at least two months prior to the commencement of the next term, failing which they have to pay the full fees for the whole term (next term). At any given time, a 12 days notice is to be given to the Academy for withdrawal during the term.

The transfer certificate is issued only after all the dues are settled.

Refund of amount lying in credit is made through an account payee cheque after obtaining a pre-receipt from the parents at the end of term in which a student is withdrawn. The caution money is refunded only after the accounts for the year have been audited.

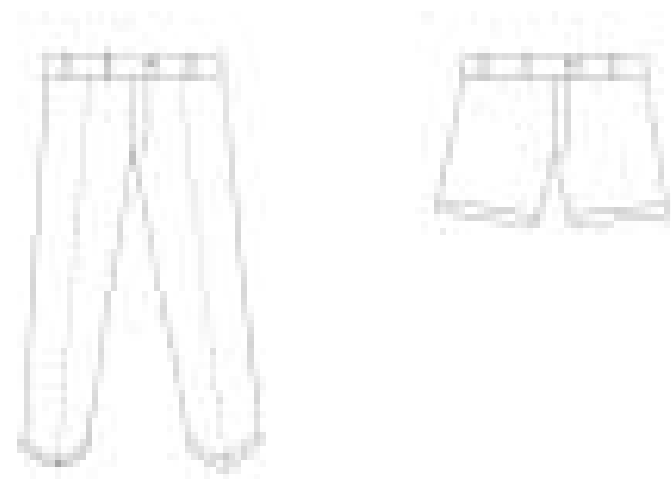

Above items are to be packed in a VIP or Similar suitcase of dimension 22"x12"x7" only

- Each clothing should be stitched with the roll Number of the student.
- Shoe should be marked inside with the roll number
- A list of clothes should be handed over to the Dorm Master/Dorm Mistress on arrival.
